Membership:	hundreds of property owners and renters in the Richmond District that reside in a geographic area surrounding Park Presidio Boulevard as bounded by Lake and Fulton Streets to the North and South and 11th and 16 th Avenues to the East and West.
Goals:	Planting and maintenance of the PPB Greenbelt Enhanced pedestrian and vehicular safety Traffic calming measures along PPB Irrigation and lighting along PPB Active neighborhood watch program Foster relationships among neighbors
Leadership:	a volunteer-run organization comprised of a 14-member executive committee, four quadrant leaders and 16 individual block captains
Membership:	\$20 per family per year
Annual Activities:	Town Hall Meeting – April Fall Festival – September Block Work Parties and Plantings – monthly Neighbors Who Lunch – Spring
Publications:	monthly e-newsletter semi-annual newsletter
